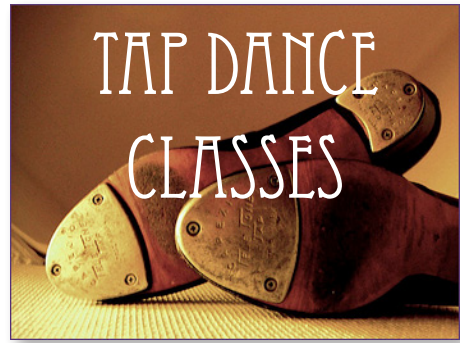

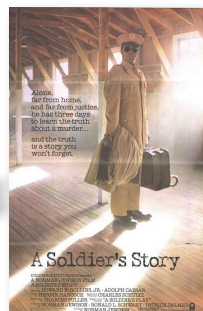

## New Management Committee

The AGM on 12 September elected a new Management Committee. Malcolm Sullivan is now President, with Lee Barwick and Judy Pearson elected as the new Vice Presidents. Joe Fleming was returned as Treasurer and Public Officer for another year. Helen Fatouros has accepted the role of Secretary. Committee members are Robin Buck, Arthur Eastwood and Cheryl Tucker.

The Special Resolution to change the Constitution to give the Management Committee authority to set the Centre's fees was defeated. The Management Committee authorises all expenditure on the centre's budget each year but currently does not have the authority to set any fee. The Constitution, drafted almost 20 years ago, stipulates that fees must be set by a meeting of all the members. Membership of the centre now stands at 750.
