Giuliano LoPo the owner of Piccola Baia is keen to support the Centre's artists and has offered prizes for outstanding pieces of work.

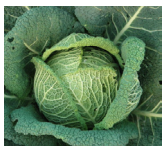

## LOCAL VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

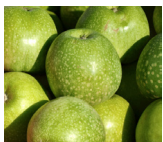

### New 8 week Art Course, "Creating Light and Shadow" with Mary van den Berk

Starts Friday 6 July 10am -12 noon

Create a sense of 3D space and volume in your paintings. Learn how to add depth and richness to your paintings using light and dark to make your work more realistic or focus on an area or create a mood.

Explore how the old masters like Rembrandt, da Vinci and Caravaggio used light and shadow to create drama, focus and mood.

Learn about chiaroscuro a classic technique which refers to the use of light and shadow to create the illusion of light from a specific source shining on the figures and objects in the painting.

Subject matter will include still life, landscapes and portraits. Students can work in any medium and all levels of ability are catered for.
